## Learning Targets & Activities for the Week

**The 7 Habits:** We celebrated our leaders with Leadership Day today. The 4<sup>th</sup> graders sang "Count on Me" during the assembly.

### Reading:

- Students are reading AR books of their choice; as well as, tracking their own monthly AR progress. Students are required to earn 30 points and receive a **passing score of 80%** on their AR tests for at least 6 nonfiction books at BL 3.0 or higher and 3 fiction books at BL 4.0 or higher each trimester. Trimester 3 includes the months of March, April, and May. **Happy Reading!**
- Miss Hwang's class is reading "Shiloh" by Phyllis Reynolds Naylor, and Mrs. Ingle's class is reading "Streams to the River, River to the Sea: A Novel or Sacagawea" by Scott O'Dell.

### Math:

- Students should be practicing their math facts, daily, for 15 minutes. Please check in with your child about the progress he/she is making on her facts. It is the goal for all students to complete all math facts by June.
- Students completed a short unit on multiplying fractions and took a posttest this week. Next week, we will begin division.

### Social Studies:

- **Native Americans:** The First People, Coastal People, Plateau People, Plains Indians.
- We learned about The Port of Everett and looked at many products around the school to find out where they came from.

### Science: Magnetism & Electricity

- Students investigated the force of magnetism, and discovered that only objects that contain iron stick to permanent magnets. We also learned that because of magnetic force, two magnets will either attract or repel one another depending on their orientation.
