Learning Targets & Activities for the Week

- **The 7 Habits:** Habit #7: Sharpen the Saw: Balance feels best.
- **Reading:** Students are reading AR books of their choice; as well as, tracking their monthly AR progress. Nov. 30 is the deadline for 1st trimester AR reading. Your student will need to read and pass with 80% accuracy at least 6 nonfiction books and have at least 30 AR points to meet 4th grade Summit 1st trimester expectations. Have your child show you their [AR record online](#) to encourage them to reach this goal.
 - ✓ Students are required to read at least 2 nonfiction books and at least one fiction book a month; as well as, earn 10 AR points a month.
 - ✓ Mrs. Ingle's class is studying *Shiloh* by Phyllis Reynolds Naylor, and Miss Hwang's class is reading *Aurore of the Yukon: A Girl's Adventure in the Klondike Gold Rush* by Keith Halliday.
- **Writing:**
 - ✓ Next week students will continue to draft their cause and effect informational essays on endangered animals.
 - ✓ Students finalized their first personal narrative about a moment they experienced in their life. Next week, we will begin the writing process again, applying new strategies to a new personal narrative.
- **Math**
 - ✓ Students took a quiz today covering the recent concepts and skills practiced in our fractions unit. We will continue with more fractions next week.
- **Science – Water Unit**
 - ✓ Students finished presenting their Water Science projects.
 - ✓ We finished our experiment on frozen water vs. water as a liquid. We discovered that frozen water is less dense than water.
- **Social Studies:**
 - ✓ Students will be playing their multicultural games, and presenting their Veterans Day projects next week.
 - ✓ Heather Lee taught a lesson on the very important Mexican holiday Day of the Dead, El dia de los muertos. During this holiday, which takes place Oct. 31 – Nov. 2, families and friends gather together to remember loved ones who have died.
