## **Learning Targets & Activities for the Week**

- **The 7 Habits:** Think Win-Win: Everyone can win.
- **Reading**
  - ✓ Students are reading AR books of their choice; as well as, tracking their monthly AR progress. Is your child progressing on their October reading goals? Ask them or have them show you their AR record online.
  - ✓ Students are required to read at least 2 nonfiction books and at least one fiction book a month; as well as, earn 10 AR points a month.
  - ✓ Mrs. Ingle's class is studying *Shiloh* by Phyllis Reynolds Naylor, and Miss Hwang's class is reading *Aurora of the Yukon: A Girl's Adventure in the Klondike Gold Rush* by Keith Halliday.
- **Writing:**
  - ✓ Students revised and edited their narrative bear stories that incorporated scientific facts. They are working on publishing their papers.
- **Math**
  - ✓ Students reviewed Unit1 on place value, addition and subtraction. They took their posttest on Thursday.
  - ✓ Next week we will begin a new math unit. Students will take a pretest on Monday to set goals for the new unit.
- **Science – Water Unit**
  - ✓ **Build a Thermometer:** Students built a bottle thermometer and conducted an investigation to find out what happens when the thermometer is placed first in hot water and then in cold water. Students discovered that water expands when heat is added and water contracts when heat is taken away.
  - ✓ **Sinking and Floating Water:** Students conducted experiments on hot water and cold water. They discovered that hot water is less dense than room temperature water and cold water is denser than room temperature water.
