Learning Targets & Activities for the Week

- **The 7 Habits:** Habit #5: Seek First to Understand, Then to Be Understood: Listen before you speak.
- **Reading**
 - ✓ Students are reading AR books of their choice; as well as, tracking their monthly AR progress. How is your child progressing on their October reading goals? Ask them or have them show you their AR record online.
 - ✓ Students are required to read at least 2 nonfiction books and at least one fiction book a month; as well as, earn 10 AR points a month.
 - ✓ Mrs. Ingle's class is studying *Shiloh* by Phyllis Reynolds Naylor, and Miss Hwang's class is reading *Aurore of the Yukon: A Girl's Adventure in the Klondike Gold Rush* by Keith Halliday.
- **Writing:**
 - ✓ Students published their narrative bear stories.
 - ✓ Students wrote an "About the Author" page about themselves.
 - ✓ Students worked on grammar this week, focusing on nouns and verbs. They practiced their note-taking skills while reviewing these concepts.
- **Math**
 - ✓ Students took a fraction pretest and compiled a list of vocabulary words related to the fraction unit that will begin after conference week.
- **Science – Water Unit**
 - ✓ **The Density of Objects in Water:** Students made predictions about what objects would sink and what objects would float in water. Students learned that objects denser than the water sink and objects that are less dense than the water float.
 - ✓ **Water Systems in Honduras:** A guest speaker who worked for the Peace Corp, came and talked to the students about water systems she helped villagers create in Honduras. Ask your students what the differences are of accessing fresh water in America vs. Honduras.
