Message from Pathfinder's School Counselor & Family Liaison, Ms. DeJardin & Ms. Amador

Hello! We are Dori DeJardin and Esther Amador, and together we support teachers, students, and families at Pathfinder in finding solutions to help each student be successful at our school. We wanted to take this opportunity to introduce ourselves, so you are aware of who we are and how we can support you and your student.

As Elementary School Counselor, Dori's role is to support the social-emotional and behavioral well-being of our students. One of Dori's main areas of focus is on helping students cope with big feelings and self-regulation so they are ready to learn. She works with students individually, in small groups, and through whole-group classroom lessons. She is also available to consult with parents and teachers. If a family feels it needs more resources or therapy outside of school, Dori can offer a list of mental health and other service providers in the community who may be able to help.
